

Our Call to Go

Have you ever been a part of a healthy church? A church thriving in evangelism, faithfully preaching the gospel, intentionally discipling and caring for one another, actively seeking Spirit-filled unity and diversity? I have. From 2014 to 2010, Liz and I lived in Louisville where healthy churches exist in nearly every part of town. I could pick from a whole treasure chest of healthy, thriving, growing churches. But that is not "the norm" for most cities in the western United States.

According to research by J.D. Payne, Idaho, Utah, and Nevada contain fifteen of the top twenty-five unreached counties in America, with 2% or less evangelical Christians per county.

These three states were also the fastest growing states by percentage in the United States in 2018-19 according to census.gov. In fact, it was recently pointed out that Idaho is growing at an average of 1000 people every day. Currently, this region is saturated with Latter Day Saints churches whose ideologies are clashing with a growing number of domestic migrants from the West Coast who hold a progressive, atheistic worldview. Both of these people groups need Jesus. With a rapid growth in population and a massive deficit of healthy churches in this region of the country, how should the church respond?

In the summer of 2020, we followed God's leading moved to Twin Falls, ID to plant Twin Falls Community Church. Idaho's affordable cost of living, family-friendly environment, geographical beauty, and booming job market has drawn thousands to relocate to this oncesmall city. Twin Falls is ripe for spiritual harvest! While its population has steadily grown, Twin Falls has seen very few churches planted in the recent years. In fact, the North American Mission Board has not planted a church in Twin Falls for seventeen years. The need for healthy churches who will faithfully preach the gospel, consistently evangelize the lost, and intentionally disciple believers has never been greater in Twin Falls.

Our mission in planting Twin Falls Community Church is to make disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ for the glory of God and the flourishing of all people. We are praying that as God grows Twin Falls Community Church, He will use this church to plant more churches in this theologically barren region of the United States. In this prospectus, we have outlined our mission, vision, and values, as well as, the community demographics of Twin Falls County and our financial needs in starting Twin Falls Community Church. We are sharing our church-planting vision with you in hopes that you will join with us in supporting God's work in Twin Falls through prayer, financial support, and/or by joining our team.


